## ANNUAL REPORT 2022-23

Thumba St. Xavier's College Alumni Association is functioning under the World Union of Jesuit Alumni (WUJA), formed during the silver jubilee year of the college in 1989. From then, the Association is functioning in a systematic manner according to a bye law. The Association was registered officially in the year 2013. The Association carries out numerous activities for the college students, which includes sponsoring the prizes of the Athappookalam competition every year, presenting scholarships for deserving students of all the Departments, organizing orientation classes and seminars for the college students. In the year 2022-23, we have successfully conducted a 3 day Xavier Alumni Fest entitled "la maree", during December 2022, in collaboration with the college.

### Minutes of the last AGM conducted on 8<sup>th</sup> May 2022 at St. Xavier's College, Thumba

The meeting started with a prayer song by Mr. Bijukumar. Sri. Kadakkal Ramesh delivered the welcome speech. The President of the Association, Adv. N.R. Sureshkumar, in his presidential address suggested that the Alumni association can extend and elaborate its activities to reach various sections of the society.
